- Encourage consultation & participation within the company to promote & maintain safe & healthy conditions.
- Investigate reported hazards promptly.
- Investigate any accident, incident, or near miss promptly and undertake corrective actions as soon as possible.
- Monitor compliance with the INTEGRATED MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (IMS).
- Monitor our Health and Safety performance.
- Develop and continually improve our INTEGRATED MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (IMS) management system.

Occupational health & safety is also the responsibility of all management, staff, and contractors.
